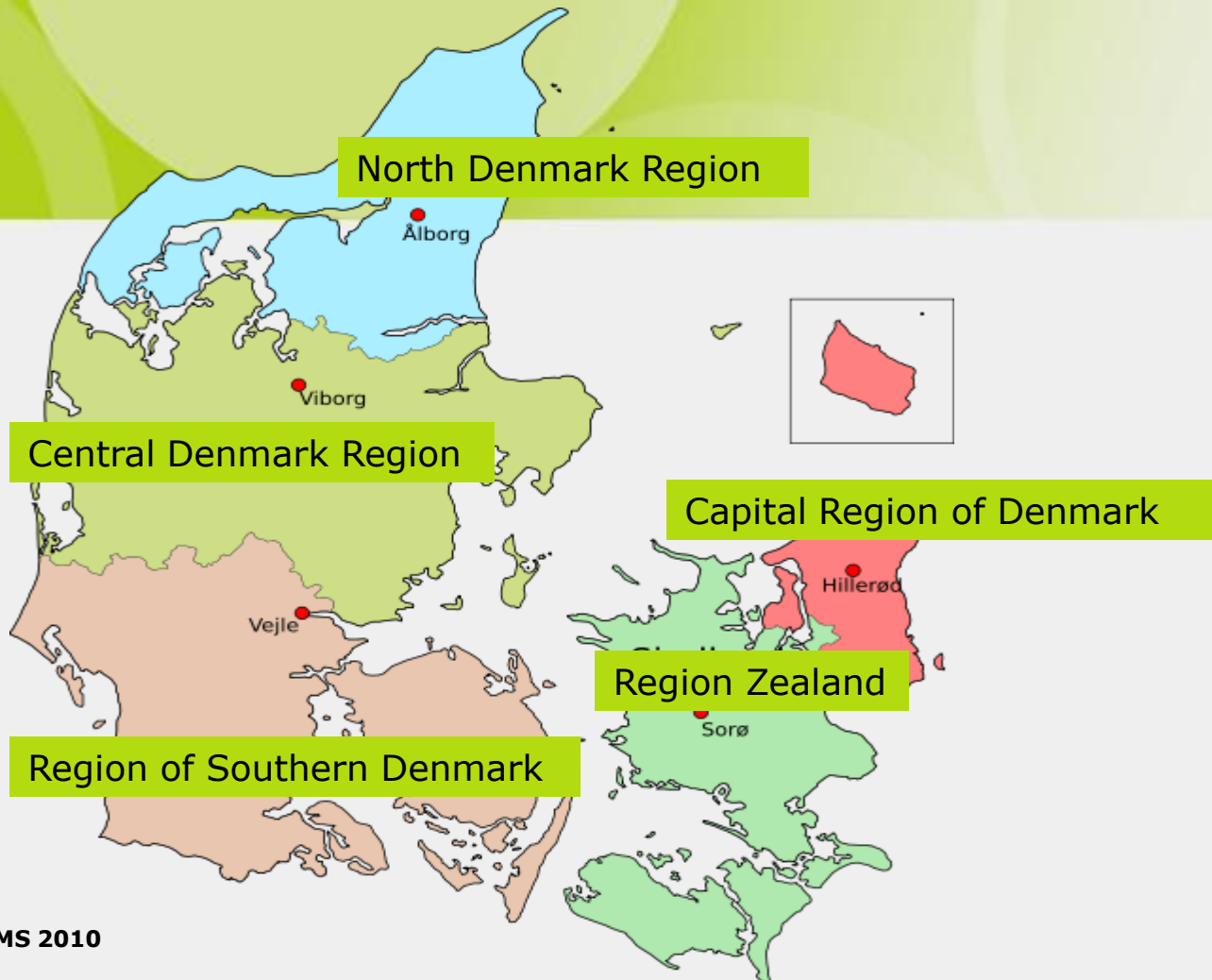

Danish Regions' overall mission is to safeguard the interests of the regions nationally as well as internationally.

The most important tasks of the organisation are:

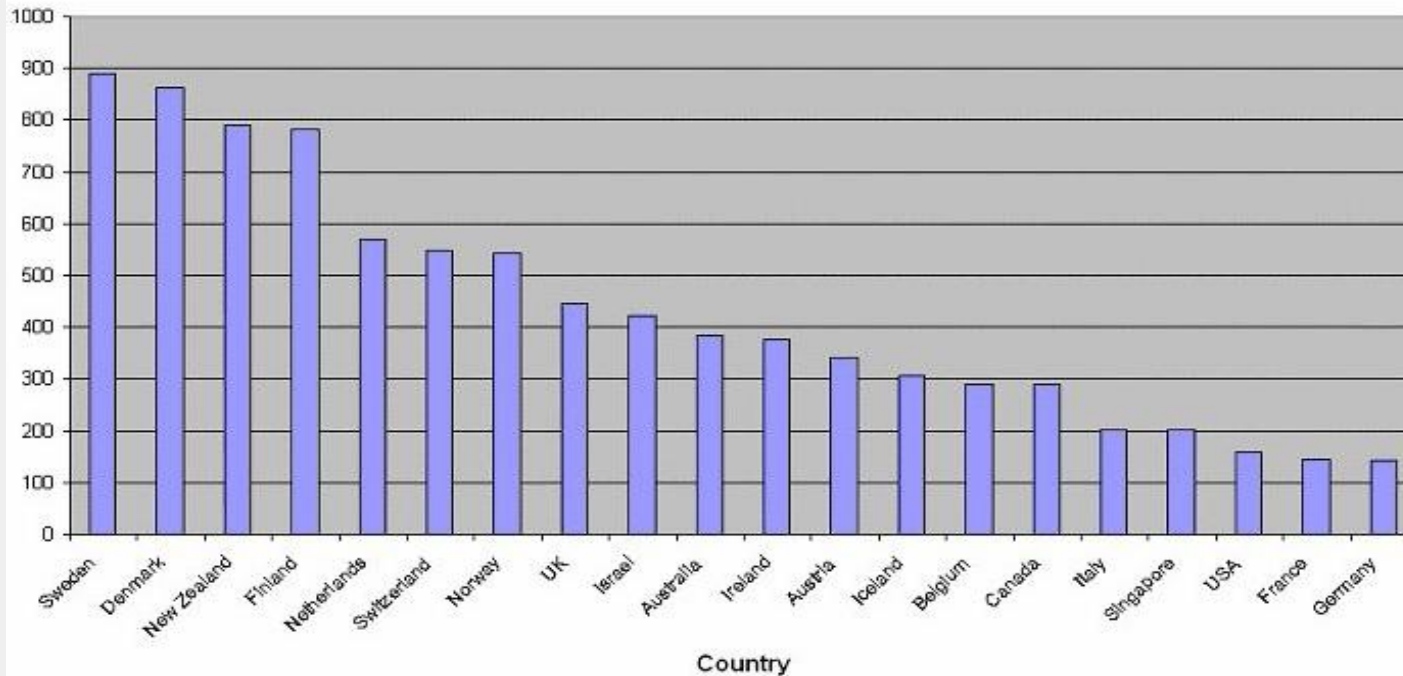
- to safeguard regional government interests

- to negotiate the annual financial frames of the regions
- to negotiate pay and working conditions for regional employees

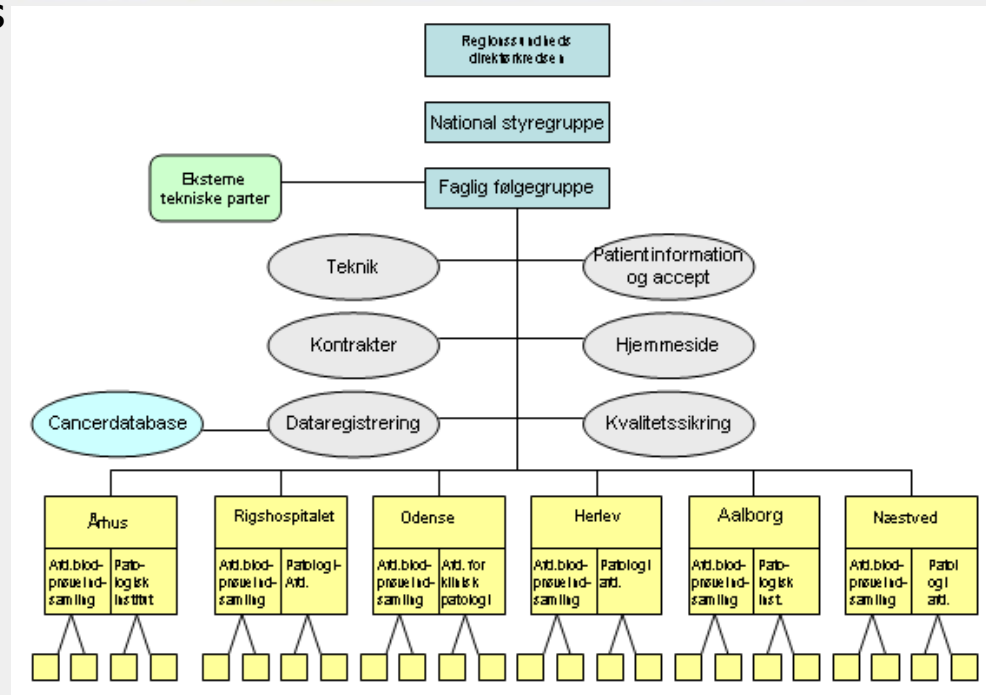
